

# 10 things to do in Glasgow



## Art Mural Trail

Discover the Glasgow Art Mural Trail, a great way to explore the city centre, enjoy a variety of street art and find out more about local history.



## Riverside Museum

A short walk from the SEC along the riverside walkway, the Riverside Museum is free to visit and tells the story of transport in Glasgow. Enjoy the replica old streets taking you back to 1895!



## Next Bikes

Hop on a city bike, with a bike station available right outside the SEC Armadillo. Explore the riverside cycle path into the city centre and beyond to Glasgow Green.



## Shopping

Browse a huge range of your favourite shops, pick up a souvenir in the city centre style mile or find quirky independent stores in the West End.



## Live music

Enjoy some live music, with over 130 music events taking place each week, including many free gigs and open mic nights.



## Go sightseeing

Take a hop on, hop off tour leaving from outside the SEC. This is a great way to explore the city if you're short on time.



## Mackintosh

Explore the works of Glasgow artist and architect Charles Rennie Mackintosh at The Lighthouse, Scotland's Centre for Architecture & Design. Or treat yourself to an afternoon tea in the Mackintosh at the Willow tearooms.



## Sample a dram

The new Clydeside Distillery is a short walk from the SEC Centre. Learn about the Glasgow docks, how whisky is made, try a dram and pick up a souvenir in the whisky shop.



## Kelvingrove Art Gallery & Museum

Take a walk to Kelvingrove Art Gallery & Museum, dating back to 1901 and housing 22 galleries, with exhibits including art, natural history and archaeology.



## Beyond the city

If you have more time, explore Scotland with a day tour leaving from Glasgow to Loch Lomond, castles, distilleries or the Highlands.
